

Eyestrain Common Issue Caused by Contact Lenses!? **Santen Launches *Soft Santear Hitomi Stretch*, an Eye Drop for Use with Soft Contact Lenses to Reduce Eyestrain by Relaxing Ciliary Muscle Stiffness Which Can Be a Cause of Eyestrain**

September 9, 2014, Osaka, Japan -- Santen Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. announced the launch of *Soft Santear Hitomi Stretch* (Pupil) *Stretch*, an OTC eye drop to be sold from September 9. This product contains two main ingredients^{*1} that reduce eyestrain by relaxing the ciliary muscle stiffness, which can be a cause of eyestrain.

◇ Reduces eyestrain caused by wearing contact lenses. *Soft Santear Hitomi Stretch* is a new eye drop product that tackles eyestrain.

Today, people spend more time looking at objects close up owing to increased use of digital devices, such as PCs and smartphones. This environment is particularly hard on contact lens wearers. There may be quite a few people who believe that “eyestrain is a common issue resulting from the use of contact lenses”.

To address people with such a problem, Santen launches *Soft Santear Hitomi Stretch* on September 9.

Soft Santear Hitomi Stretch contains two ingredients, neostigmine methylsulfate and vitamin B₁₂, which directly work to reduce ciliary muscle stiffness causing eyestrain, as well as the highest concentration^{*2} of vitamin B₆ to activate tissue metabolism for reducing strain. This product alleviates eyestrain by relaxing the strain on eyes caused by wearing contact lenses. In addition, the product can be used by people wearing, soft, hard, O₂, and disposable contact lenses.^{*3}

The *Soft Santear* series, which includes this new product, is preservative^{*4}-free. It is suitable for use with children.^{*5} This series can be used by a wide range of people, both contact lens wearers and non-wearers.
