## Precautions for use



### Consultation

1. The following people should consult with their doctor, pharmacist, or registered pharmaceutical distributor before using this product.
  - (1) People receiving eye treatment from a doctor
  - (2) People who have experienced an allergic reaction to medicine or other substances
  - (3) Anyone with the following symptoms: Continual eye mucus and severe eye pain
2. If you experience any of the following symptoms after using this product, it may be an adverse reaction. In such a case, please stop using the product immediately, take this information form to your doctor, pharmacist, or registered pharmaceutical distributor and seek consultation.

## Dosage / Administration

Wash your eyes by applying 4 to 6 drops at a time, 3 to 6 times daily.

\*For details on how to use it, see the figure to the right.

### • Please observe the following precautions.

- (1) If administered to a child, the product must be administered under the direction and observation of the child's guardian.
- (2) Do not let the tip of the bottle touch your eyes, eyelids or eyelashes (doing so could cause the solution to become contaminated with eye mucus or bacteria). Do not use the product if it does become contaminated.
- (3) Use only as an eye wash.
- (4) If using this product together with medicated eye drops, use the eye wash first.
- (5) Do not use the product while wearing colored contact lenses.
- (6) If the feeling of foreign matter in your eyes does not improve even after using this product, or if you feel any abnormality at all when wearing contact lenses, remove your contact lenses and see an ophthalmologist immediately. If using contact lenses, follow the precautions for their use.

## Indication

Washing eyes (including while wearing hard or soft contact lenses), prevention of eye disease (after swimming, when dust or sweat enters the eyes, etc.)

## Ingredients and quantity

Ingredients: Boric acid, Quantity: 10%

This product contains the following additives: edetate sodium hydrate, povidone, isotonicizing agent, pH-adjusting agent.

## Precautions regarding storage and handling

- (1) Store in a cool place away from direct sunlight and keep sealed. To preserve the quality of the product, do not leave it in a hot place such as inside a car or near a heater. If the product is left in a hot place, the bottle may become warped causing the solution to leak and degrading its quality. Please do not use the product in such a case.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer the solution to another receptacle. (Doing so may lead to misuse of the product or may affect its quality.)
- (4) Do not share the product with another person.
- (5) Do not use the product if it has exceeded its use-by date. Even before the use-by date, please use the product within approximately 1 month of opening the bottle.
- (6) Depending on the conditions of storage, the ingredients may crystallize and form deposits around the inside of the bottle's tip or on the inside of the cap. If this occurs, gently wipe off the deposits with a clean piece of gauze before using the product.

## How to use



Prepare a clean tissue or towel in advance to wipe up overflowing liquid.

With a clean hand, pull on your lower eyelid and put in 4 to 6 drops at a time to wash out your eye. When doing so, be careful not to let the tip of the bottle touch your eyelids, eyelashes, or eye.
